Through my art, I illustrate how fresh produce can be enjoyed as delicious meals.

I am stirred by scenes of local horticulture, agriculture and landscapes. Good food is such bliss and one of life's great joys but we will not be able to support the increasing size of the population under the current food system if people do not start eating local and becoming more responsible for their own food supply. I show this with portraits of children and fresh produce, table-scapes set with meals and an abundance of ingredients, vases of herbs, foraged and native foods and flat lays. The future of the food supply is going to need drastic changes in order to provide. I try to communicate my passion for this subject through my art.

I see my artistic journey as pre and post- 'the car accident in 2017, 'that broke my shoulder and stopped me (temporarily) from using my right arm and hand. Unfortunately, the accident and the following surgery meant that I had to learn how to move my arm again. It was only 3 years ago in 2019 that I was able and confident enough to paint again and still have some limits in my movements. The sabbatical that I took during the years of physio and rehab, helped focus my passion to examine soil health, food sustainability, the cycle of life and humans' relationship with Earth's natural resources.
